1. Call to Order

The meeting to order at 5:00 PM by Chairman, Bob Douglas.

2. Roll Call

Commissioners present were Douglas, Kettner, and Sperstad. McAdams and Perkins were excused. Mukwonago Police personnel also present were Chief Dan Streit, and Assistant Chief Chris DeMotto.

3. Approval of minutes from the November 19th, 2024 meeting.

Motion by Kettner, second by Sperstad approved unanimously.

4. Public Comment

No public present

5. New Business

5.1 Chief Update:

- Bid opening for the garage addition and roof replacement on the existing police department building was today. Campbell Construction was the lowest bid. Their bid is approximately \$385,000 under budget. In addition to the construction costs, we need to purchase other items necessary for the project such as storage lockers and work benches and/or shelves.
- The new squad is delayed by one month. Production is now at the end of April, and we should take delivery by the end of May.
- Mukwonago dispatch started receiving cellular 9-1-1 calls from T-Mobile in March and should receive calls from the other major carriers in the next month or two. This is a major accomplishment as we have been trying to get our native 9-1-1 calls for over 20 years.
- Our new dispatcher, Josh Adams, has been training for about four weeks. He is doing very well, and everyone seems to be getting along with him.
- Lt. Kubiak was released by his doctor to full duty.
- Chief Streit announced he is planning to retire next year sometime after May 2. He wanted to let the commission know early so they could begin thinking about his replacement. The chief also notified President Winchowky, Village Administrator Dykstra, and the police department command staff. We discussed succession planning, and Chief Streit is preparing Assistant Chief DeMotto to replace him should the commission decide to go in that direction.

6. Adjournment

Motion to adjourn was made at 5:43 p.m. by Sperstad and a second from Kettner. All approved.
