Public Hearing regarding **Resolution 2026-16** a resolution to vacate and discontinue a portion of the right-of-way on Marsh View Drive near Black Bear Drive

Motion by Winchowky to approve, second by Brill. No discussion. Motion carried 6-0.

Discussion/Action regarding Resolution 2026-32 a resolution confirming the Village President's appointments to the Standing Committees for the Village of Mukwonago

Motion by Winchowky to approve, second by K. Johnson. No discussion. Motion carried 6-0.

Discussion/Recommendation regarding next steps for Village Board Trustee Vacancy

Clerk Kropf explained the possible next steps that the Board could take, based on her recommendations located in the packet. General discussion was held concerning timelines and procedures of the appointment to a trustee vacancy. D. Johnson and K. Johnson wanted to have the election of the new Board member on the August 11, 2026 Partisan Primary, but Clerk Kropf noted that the deadline has passed.

Motion by Winchowky to appoint someone to fill the vacancy until April 2027, second by Reeves. Motion carried on a roll call vote 4-2, with D. Johnson and K. Johnson voting no.
